

For little brother there is a suit, which for him is a pain. Thus his mother's efforts to put it on are all in vain.




Here is the party table. Each glass with a guests name label.




The guests are waiting for the cake to come. But where has little brother gone?




Under the table search at least two, but even that won't do.

Later in his sister's care, she makes him aware. A skirt makes you a gay, so now put it away!




But as he lays there weeping, he hear something piping.
